

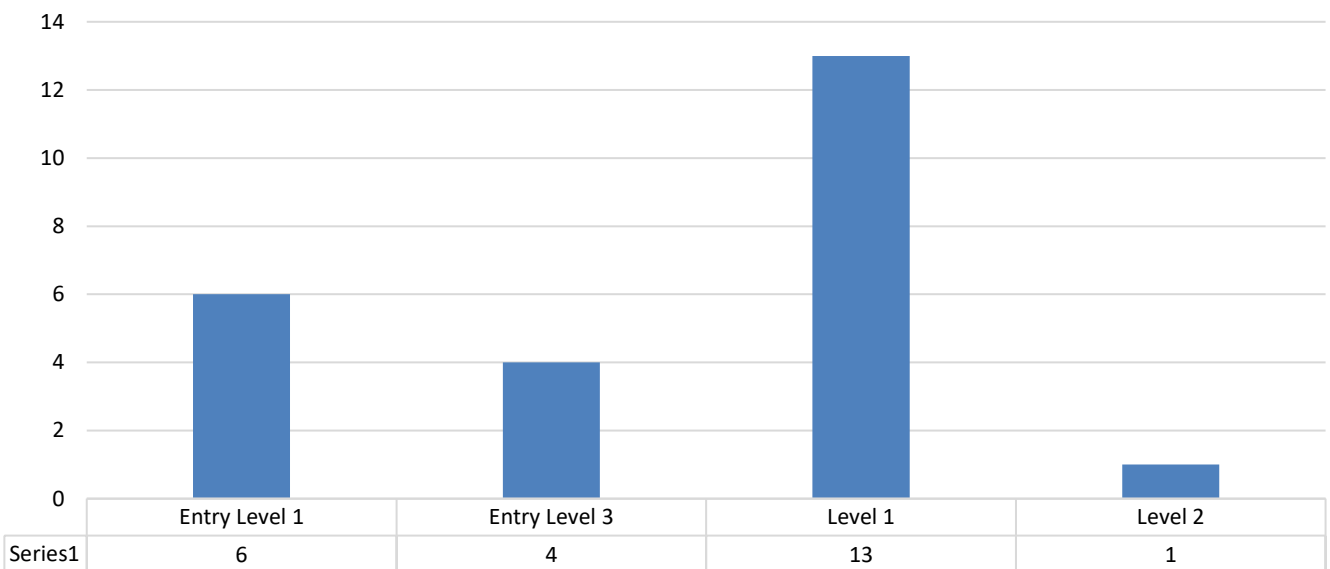
# Key Stage 4 Progression Summary 2023

(Where did our Year 11s progress to and what types and levels of course are they following?)

## Summary:

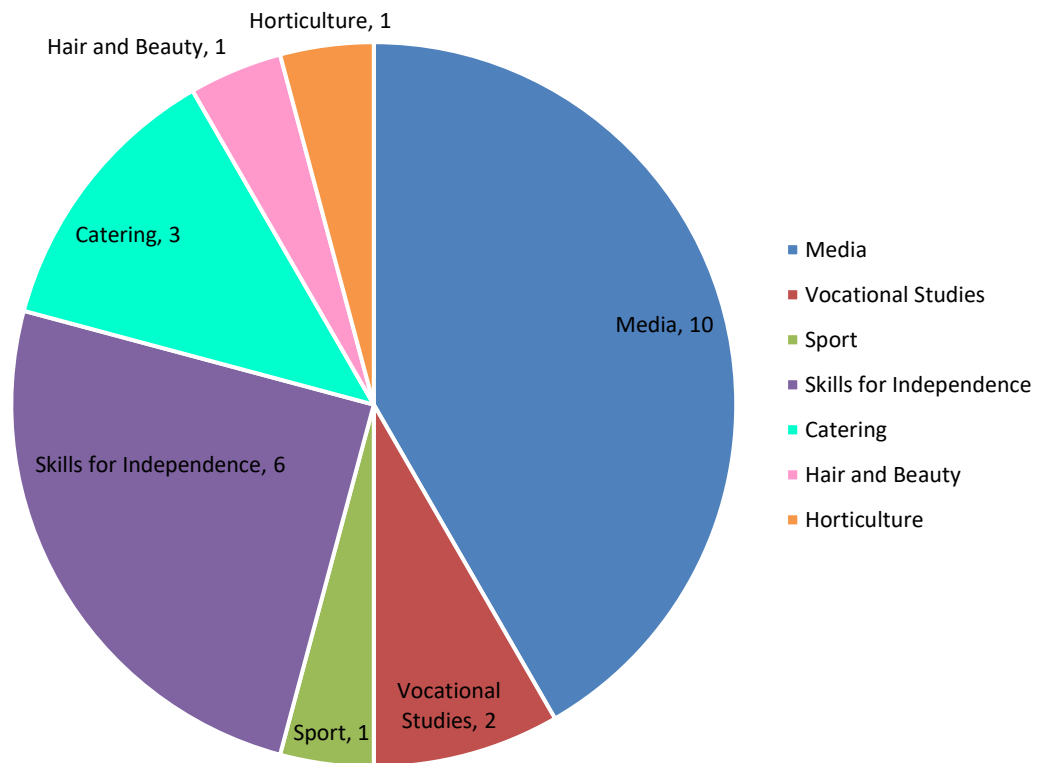
- All 24 students progressed to appropriate post-16 courses in Year 12.
- All 24 students from Year 11, having been given independent careers guidance, decided to progress to our Sixth Form programme, which includes a vocational course at a quality-assured external provider matched to their interests and abilities, as below.
- School self-evaluation is that these outcomes are consistent with the July 2018 Ofsted judgement that 'Leaders' partnership and quality-assurance work with other sixth-form providers is exceptional'

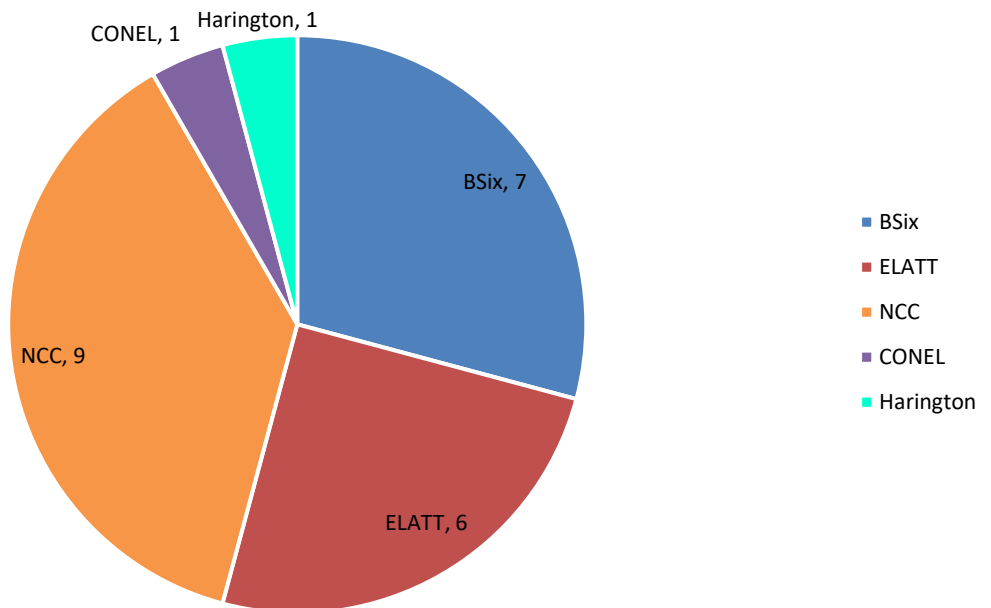

**Notes:**

- One student accesses a four day course at an external provider and does one day in our Sixth Form programme as it was deemed important for their progress, continuity and well being that they remained part of Stormont House. They receive therapeutic input as well as attending Maths, English and Preparation for Adulthood lessons at Stormont House.
- This cohort had slightly lower attainment levels at the end of KS4 than previous cohorts leading to more EL1 and L1 courses, due to their lower KS3 baseline scores. They also had to contend with two years of disruption due to the Covid pandemic.
