4	<p>HUMAN RESOURCES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Committee discusses a human resources update prepared by KM. The file is available in the governor’s portal. The School has a good record in retaining good agency staff that work here temporarily. - Apprenticeship levy. The Master in Senior Education Leadership is offered and available to staff. GM is undertaking it. The School is identifying a range of courses, among which also coaching. 		
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7	<p>Audit and Risk:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Risk register: finance has been added in yellow as a risk as we are in the red now. The committee will continuously review risks that should be on the list. 		
8	<p>Premises</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - GC: The Facilities Management contract is under constant review. This might lead to some significant savings in the future. Nothing to report about the general running of the site. 		
9	<p>H&S and well being</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - DfE Wellbeing charter. In our interest we should demonstrate what is our evidence that we are committed to it. The H&S committee has drafted a document with action points on the well-being charter. The Committee approves signing up to the charter. - Staff development is covered and KM will share a diagram of staff development prepared by H&S. 	GC	GC will circulate it to the staff and parents as well as use it in recruitment.
