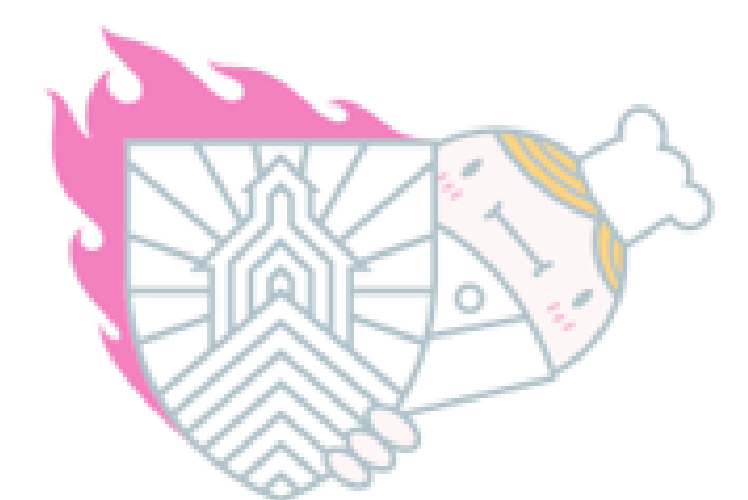

Autism referral and post-diagnostic support in Hackney

General information about autism in Hackney including how to get a diagnosis for children, young people and adults can be found here.

Please read all the information carefully as referrals may need to be made by a professional such as a GP, Health Visitor, Teacher, Social Worker, or health professional.

There are forms/referral packs included and attached as documents to the correct age relevant service entries and linked to in the general autism information article.

Usually, after an autism diagnosis the parents will also be given information about a choice of post-diagnostic information sessions e.g. Early Bird Plus, Pegasus, or Next Steps.

If the child already has a diagnosis of autism and this was provided via CAMHS or services at Hackney ARK you can access regular autism information sessions run either at CAMHS or Hackney Ark.

Autism Parents Coffee Morning (CAMHS Disability)
NDT (Neuro-Developmental Team) Parent-Carer Coffee Morning

Available to any parents of an autistic child or young person in Hackney.

The Family Coach Service is also offering Autism Education Trust training for parents as well as the Parent Empowerment sessions and other training offers as described here.

Parents can also access the Educational Psychology Parents Advice Sessions offer a FREE 30 minute 1:1 session to talk through challenges or difficulties.

Hackney's Autism Practitioner Rober Raby is also a route to information and support for parents and young people.

The NAS Teen Life specialist parenting programme will be run several times throughout the year including online and in person options.

For those over 16 you can access advice on autism from Hackney has an Autism Lead for Social Work.

If the child is not already known to Hackney Ark and the diagnosis was from an out-of-borough service you can get advice on how to understand and support children with autism from Autism Central run by Contact.

Autism Central is a new national service. Any parent or carer of a child with autism can sign up for Autism central training, resources and workshops.

Good to know - Experienced and trained parents from Hackney have been successfully recruited and trained by Contact and NAS to help deliver this service including a Turkish speaking trainer.

These parent-trainers will also have information about local services but please do also signpost parents to Hackney's 0-25 SEND Local Offer website.
